Hand Lamination Department: Sandra Gonzales Hernandez, Yesica Perez Penaloza, Savannah Kennedy, and Cynthia Galaviz are responsible for laminating graphics onto the Panaflex, following the specific design specifications provided by the customer.

Express Graphics Zund Plotter Operator: Teresa Roberts operates the Zund plotter, cutting images from the film laminated by the Panaflex Laminator. She also cuts graphics to be laminated onto the Panaflex, adhering to the customer's design specifications.

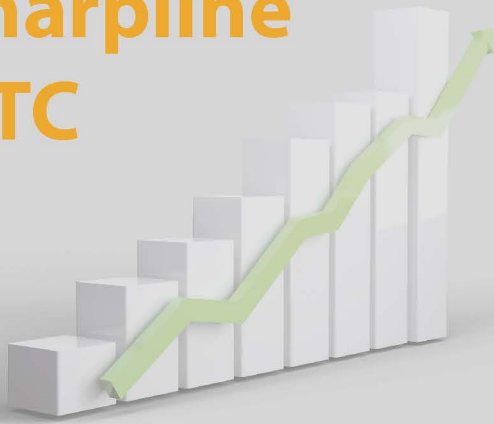
